#### Inviting Organizations

**ConAct – Coordination Center for German-Israeli Youth Exchange** works on behalf of the German Federal Ministry for Family Affairs, Senior Citizens, Women and Youth, supported by the federal states of Saxony-Anhalt and Mecklenburg-Vorpommern. ConAct administers the funding of German-Israeli youth exchange, supports and qualifies German-Israeli exchange partnerships and advances German-Israeli youth contacts. The project "Living Diversity in Germany and Israel" is funded by the Federal Ministry for Family Affairs, Senior Citizens, Women and Youth through the German federal program "Live Democracy!" as well as through support from the Israeli Youth Exchange Authority. The project is running from 2015 to 2018.
