



Reflect & Plan 2008: 60 years of Israel

Bilateral Seminar for Israeli and German partners involved in exchange-projects

Date: 18th to 22th (25th) May 2008

Location: Lutherstadt Wittenberg and Berlin

The Israel Youth Exchange Council and ConAct are inviting active partner-organisations in German-Israeli exchange projects to participate in the *Reflect&Plan – Seminar*.

The programme will offer the chance to get together personally, to reflect and improve mutual cooperation in order to develop new ideas and shared projects for the future. The seminar will open up a space to discuss questions of contents, structure and logistics in a productive atmosphere of sharing experiences with other active cooperating partners. Lectures focusing on the topic will offer additional inspiration.

The main focus will be on the topic **60** years of Israel:

- Which materials are being used for the preparation of groups on the German side?
- Which activities in the course of the encounters in Israel show the variety and give a sense of the challenges of Israeli daily life?
- How is the history and presence of Israel picked up?
- How do Israeli youngsters see themselves and their country today, and how is it reflected in German-Israeli meetings?
- How is the challenge of shared commemoration of the Shoah dealt with in the programmes?

Target group:

Representatives/group-leaders of German-Israeli youth- and professional exchange projects who are involved in the project-list 2008 or who wish to renew an existing partnership or who want keep-in-touch with their existing partners.

In order to have lasting effects of the work process, the condition for participation is that the project partners – both from Germany and Israel – will be participating in the seminar.
